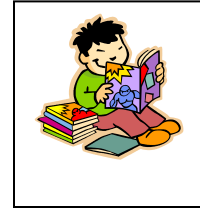

Unidad 1 Etapa 1
El Libro de Niños



Description of Task:

Students will create and present either a hand-crafted or PowerPoint version of a Children's Book.

Task Requirements:

1. Students will randomly be divided by the teacher into groups of 4.
2. Within each group, each individual student is responsible for one chapter (a chapter shall be defined as 5 "pages"). The total book will be 20 pages. This will be one test grade.
3. The following items need to be included on each "page"
 - a. An illustration that accurately depicts the story-line of the page.
 - b. There must be at least 3 sentences on each "page". The students should incorporate the preterit and imperfect in the story as much as possible.
 - c. Students must make an attempt to use as much of the vocabulary from Unidad 1 Etapa 1 as possible.
4. Students will work collaboratively to ensure that the book transitions smoothly from chapter to chapter.
5. Students will be given at least (1) 90-minute block period to work on this task. Students will also have an option to have the book edited by their peers or the teacher. Students will be given access to the computer lab.
6. Upon completion of the written book, students will present their books to the class.
 - a. Each individual student will read the part of the story that they have written, while one other member of the group is acting out the story-line.
 - b. Each student will be responsible for presenting their part of the story and acting out at least ONE other chapter.

7. The students who are not presenting (or have finished presenting) must pay careful attention to the other presentations. Upon completion of all the presentations, each group will be randomly assigned to write a chapter summary of one of the presentations. For instance, the first group that presents may have to write a chapter summary of the third group that presents. The chapter summary will be 4-5 sentences in length and will be carried out in Spanish. The chapter summary will be a quiz grade separate from the project grade.

Grading the Task:

This project will carry the weight of 1 test grade and 1 quiz grade

The written book (including illustrations) and the oral presentation are the test grade.

The chapter summary is the quiz grade.
